- Removal action is limited as it is still in progress
- EPA must replace property to pre removal condition.
- Discussed that EPA will be responsible for costs related to removal depending on what is found.
- Remove 1 to 2 feet of soil to determine level of contaminants

- August to November conduct yard cleanups
- November to February – no yard cleanups
- March – TBD
